<b>Country/(ies) or region supported</b>	<p>The RCN will support and fund coordinators and partners from Norwegian institutions in projects under this call, including their partners from Low- and Lower-Middle Income Countries (LLMICs) as defined in the <a href="#">OECD DAC list</a> as "least developed countries (LDCs), low-income countries, and lower middle-income countries and territories which are not LDCs". We do not fund partners from "upper middle-income countries and territories".</p> <p>The RCN will only fund partners from LLMICs in projects where eligible Norwegian institutions are coordinators or partners.</p>
<b>Description/qualifications of eligible participants</b>	The RCN will support Norwegian institutions eligible to receive funds through the RCN. <a href="#">List of approved research organisations</a> .

<b>Type of contribution + amount of contribution (R\$)</b>	Monetary. The total funding available to Norwegian participants and their LLMIC partners for this call is up to 870 000 EUR (10 million NOK).
